## **WARRANTY AND CARE**

#### **CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF YOUR NEW FLOOR:**

Always use thick felt furniture and leg protectors. Avoid extended exposure to direct sunlight especially during peak sunlight hours. Regular sweeping or vacuuming and occasional washing with clean warm water will keep your new floor clean and beautiful.

To thoroughly clean your floor, use a damp sponge mop dipped in a warm water/white vinegar solution. Like many other types of floors, vinyl floors become slippery when wet so always wipe up spills immediately and when cleaning the floor allow adequate time to dry before walking on the floor.

#### **WARRANTY INFORMATION**

##### ***Limited Lifetime Residential, 15-Year Commercial Warranty:***

This product is warranted by the manufacturer to the original purchaser against manufacturing defects and pattern wear-thru under normal residential and commercial usage when installed and maintained according to the instructions printed on the back or supplied within each carton. Under this warranty, the manufacturer will repair or, at his option, furnish replacement material of similar design, color, and quality as the defective material. If a manufacturing defect becomes evident within the warranted time period, you should notify the retailer immediately, in writing, and supply proof of purchase, a detailed description of the defect, along with a sample, and/or photograph if possible. No other expressed warranties are given. Repair or replacement of the defective product is your only remedy. In no event shall the manufacturer be liable for consequential or incidental damages or expenses of any kind or amount no matter what the cost.

##### **This warranty does NOT cover the following:**

- Any usage other than interior residential or interior commercial
- Labor and/or material costs involved in removing defective product and installing the replacement
- Damage due to excessive moisture, alkaline substances, or hydrostatic pressure in the subfloor
- Dissatisfaction due to improper installation and maintenance.
- Damage due to stains, scratches, gouges, scuffs, indentations, punctures, tears, or burns
- Discoloration, curling, buckling, or gapping due to extended exposure to direct sunlight

-Planks installed in seasonal dwellings, unheated porches, or installations where there are extreme temperature variations

-Intentional misuse

-Bonding issues resulting from use of non-recommended subfloors, adhesives, sealers, embossing levelers, and other installation materials are the sole responsibility of the contractor and/or manufacturer of the particular items
